HELPFUL NOTES

- If you order tickets online you will not get a physical ticket. When you check-in, it will list the number of tickets purchased. Have your confirmation email ready just in case.
- If you want floor access, purchase a Parent Pass. Parents will not be able to enter the main competition floor without a pass.
- We ask competitors to arrive early due to traffic, parking, getting seats, and checking in. Once you check-in, purchase the boards that you will need for competition time.

AWARDS

All competitors will receive a medal or trophy (as labled for each event type) and awarded one of the following placements: 1 – Eagle \mid 2 – Dragon \mid 3 – Tiger

SCORING

Competitor placements will be based on the collaboration of the judges. In the case of a tie, judges will have competitors perform a second time and will be judged on second performance.

INTRODUCTIONS

Competitors will introduce themselves prior to competing in breaking, forms, and weapons (for black belts). The proper introduction is listed with each event's rules below.

BREAKING EVENT (GOLD MEDAL)

Boards will be purchased upon arrival to the Championship. *Introduction: Judges, my name is (say your name). My breaking techniques are (say breaking techniques). With your permission, I will begin.*

For children, writing their breaking technique on each board with permanent marker before they compete in their rings will speed up time. Boards are \$3/each.

- 1. Age 12 and under: ¼ inch boards
- 2. Age 13 and above: ½ inch boards
- 3. Speed/Combination Breaks: ¼ inch boards
- 4. Only approved competition designated holders are allowed to hold in breaking.
- 5. Simultaneous breaks (when both boards break at the same time) count as a single break. For example: Split Kick, Double Knife Hand Strikes, etc.
- 6. Jumping Kicks with multiple breaks that are NOT simultaneous count as one break <u>ONLY</u> if the competitor is in the air the entire time. For Example: Double and Triple Front Snap Kicks.
- 7. Head breaks and jumping off objects or people WILL NOT be permitted.
- 8. Black Belts are required to complete a 4-way break: 1 hand, 2 feet, 1 freestyle.
 - Freestyle breaks can be a combination break such as a double or triple kick, however, competitors must do breaks simultaneously or complete in the air to count as one break.
 - Two minutes total to set-up and break (maximum one-minute set-up time recommended.) Clock starts when competitor steps into the competition area. Black belts may use multiple boards (stacked boards) when breaking.
- 9. Color Belts are required to complete a 3-way break: 2 feet and 1 hand combination.
 - Two minutes total to set up and break. Clock starts when competitor steps into competition area. One board per break only (no stacked boards).

WEAPONS (BLACK BELTS ONLY | GOLD MEDAL)

Introduction: Judges, my name is (say your name). My weapon is (say name of weapon). With your permission, I will begin.

- 1. Competitors will have 1 minute to perform a Freestyle routine without music.
- 2. To utilize time efficiently, competitors may demonstrate routines simultaneously

- with other competitors.
- 3. Weapons must be dull, any sharp weapons will not be permitted.
- 4. All swords must be full tang to ensure safety. Only 2nd dans and above, ages 13 and above, may use live blade swords.

POOMSAE/FORMS EVENT (3-FOOT TROPHY)

- To utilize time efficiently, competitors may demonstrate poomsae simultaneously with other competitors.
- 2. Demonstrate the appropriate form for your belt level (no creative forms).
- 3. Black Belt Competitors who receive Eagle Placement will compete for poomsae Grand Champion. The Grand Champion receives a 6-foot trophy.
- 4. For Black Belts:
 - 1st Dan: Koryo or Keumgang
 - 2nd Dan: Keumgang or Taebaek
 - 3rd Dan: Taebaek or Pyongwon
 - 4th Dan: Pyongwon or Sipjin
 - 5th Dan: Sipjin or Jitae
 - 6th Dan: Jitae or Cheongwon
 - If your school uses a different form system, please choose the form that matches with your Dan.

SPARRING COMPETITION (GOLD MEDAL)

- 1. Absolutely no head shots.
- 2. Light contact only.
- 3. All safety equipment REQUIRED
 - Chest and head gear
 - Mouth piece
 - Fist/Forearm and Shin/Foot protector
 - Protective cup (mandatory for males)
 - Competitor may not compete without all gear

Match duration

- 1. Children Color Belts (3-12): One 1 minute round
- 2. Adult Color Belts (13+): One 2 minute round
- 3. All Black Belts: One 2 minute round
- 4. Competition time stops when a match is paused and resumes when a match continues.

3 Points Rule

- 1. Match ends when first competitor scores 3 positive points (win) or 3 negative points (loss).
- 2. If neither competitor reaches 3 points within match duration, time keeper will toss bean bag into the ring, signaling referee to stop the match. Competitor with most points win.
- 3. At time, if competitors are tied, referee will announce sudden death round, which will continue until a point is scored for the win.

Scoring Points

- 1. Punch 1 point
 - Straight punch delivered with fist to middle part of the chest guard area.
 - All punches must be a solid hit, but must be light contact.
 - No punches to the face or any part of head or
- 2. Kick 1 point
 - All kicks must be a solid hit, but must be light
 - Valid kicking areas: front, both left and right side of the chest guard.
 - Switch kicks are allowed, however, jumping kicks are not.
- 3. Again, NO HEAD SHOTS.

Warning & Deduction Points

- 1. 2 warnings will result in automatic point deduction.
- 2. Immediate disqualification after 4 warnings.

Negative Acts

- Evading by turning back to the opponent
- Falling down
- Avoiding the match
- Turtling, grabbing, holding, pushing opponent
- Pretending injury
- Attacking below the waist
- Undesirable acts
- Attacking head, shoulders, knees and toes, knees and toes

Prohibited Acts

- Attacking the opponent after referee stops
- Throwing opponents
- Interrupting progress of the match to contestant or coach
- Excessive force
- Head shots- disqualification no warnings given

Note: whether a warning, penalty or disqualification is assessed depends upon the severity of the violation and the intent of the violator. No point will be scored for any successful punch or kick when it is followed by a violation.

Team Competition Fee: \$500.00 per team

Prizes: All teams will be competing within the same competition grouping regardless of the size or makeup of the team. All teams will be competing for one of the top three prizes:

Don Ault Eagle Award:\$3,000.00Kevin Gardner Dragon Award:\$2,000.00Dave Johnson Tiger Award:\$1,000.00

Coaching: Heads of Schools may not be a member of the participating team. No coaching or instruction from coaches allowed during the demonstration. All coaching or instructions must only be given by a participating team member during the demonstration. Coaches may assist with Music.

Participants: All team members MUST be students that are currently enrolled and active members of the school participating in the demonstration. All team members MUST participate in at least one individual event during the Championship. All team members must also have an active role in the demonstration.

Team Size: Although, we have set no minimum or maximum number to team competitors, we do suggest teams no smaller than 15 members. Extra consideration will be awarded to teams with 25+ members.

Time Permitted: Each team will be allocated 7 minutes for the team competition, with time (and judging) beginning at the team's first bow and ending at the team's final bow. In addition to the demonstration time, set-up and clean-up time time may not surpass 1-minute. Distribution of time is at the discretion of the participating team. Deductions will be made for exceeding the time allowed. Additional Information: Props, costumes and equipment are allowed. All Weapons must be imitations (no live blades). Concrete and bricks may be used as prop/equipment, however not as a breaking material. The use of flowers, confetti, etc. are allowed but these must be cleaned up within the allocated clean-up time limit. No water, fruit, or liquid is permitted as demonstration material. All breaks must be attributed to breakers ability (board holders may not force or push boards into a breakers kicks). Teams may bring their own boards for use in the team demonstration, however, these will be inspected and quarantined until the time of the competition. Practice time for the competition will be provided prior to the competition.

Judging Criteria: 1) Team Spirit, 2) Teamwork, 3) Originality/Creativity, 4) Level and Performance of Techniques, 5) Team Inclusivity, and 6) Entertainment Value.


